Funeral Services Planned for Educator Henry Leeds

Services for Henry H. Leeds, principal of Canoga Park High School from 1967 to 1971, will be conducted by Rabbi Steven Jacobs today at 2 p.m. in Temple Judea, 5429 Lindley Ave., Tarzana.

The educator died Tuesday at Kaiser Hospital in Panorama City. He was 50.

A native of Pennsylvania, Mr. Leeds had been in the education field for 25 years serving as registrar at both Birmingham and Grover Cleveland High Schools and boys' vice principal at Reseda High School before transferring to Canoga Park.

Served in Navy

Mr. Leeds held a Bachelor of science degree from Indiana State College and a Master of science from University of Southern California.

A veteran of World War II, Mr. Leeds retired from service as a lieutenant in the United States Naval Reserve.

For the past two years he had been assigned to the Los Angeles Board of Education office of staff development programs.

He also was dean of administrative services at Glendale College of Law

He was president of the local Phi Delta Kappa chapter, an organization of educators. He was a member of the Canoga Park Kiwanis Club and the F&AM Lodge, Woodland Hills.

Surviving him are his wife Lee and children Susan, Nancy and Craig, all of Sherman Oaks; parents Mr. and Mrs. Myer Leeds, Los Angeles, and a sister Mrs. Harold Harte of North Hollywood.
