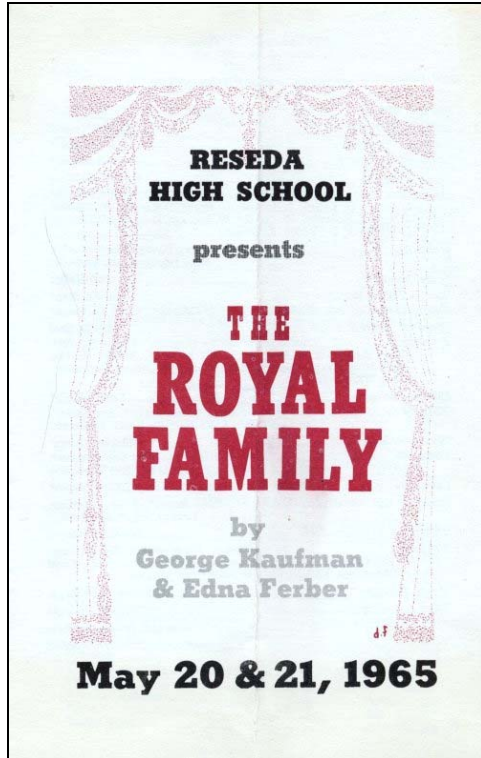


Drama Production Memories 1965 – The Royal Family
