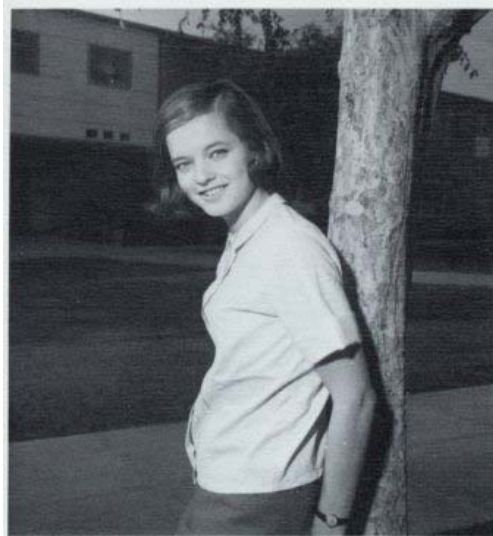
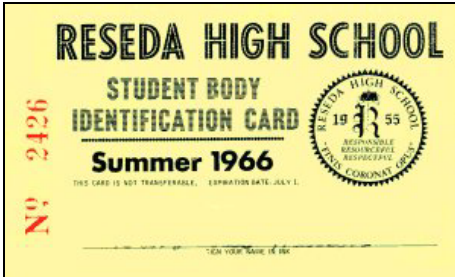


Life on Campus IV
