

Sports Memories: Cross Country

Defending city champion in all three divisions, Granada Hills made an easy victory over Reseda in the first meet by a score of 7 to 46. The most outstanding Regent in that meet was Mike Glascock with a time of 9 minutes, 15 seconds on the 1.8 mile Pierce College course.
